## Huntington Hospital Main Entrance is Closed between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

### Huntington Hospital Security Upgrade

Huntington Hospital has upgraded security protocols. Because of this, the front door main entrance off of California Blvd. is now closed and locked every night between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following morning.

All patients who need to enter the Hospital for any reason must enter through the emergency room front door.

Parking is available in the EAST structure located on Fairmount just off of Congress Street. The easiest access is to take Fair Oaks Ave. to Congress Street and turn west towards the Hospital.

### **If you are an OB patient who needs to go to the Labor and Delivery area, please note:**

1. There are signs placed around the Hospital to help direct you.
2. Enter the ED Lobby using the doors below the RED EMERGENCY SIGN. (#2 on the MAP)
3. At the far end of the lobby, there will be a security guard. You will receive a badge designated for Labor and Delivery and Maternity.
4. There will be someone available to escort you to L&D if you cannot find your way there on your own. Do not check in as a patient in the ED. This is just the way into the hospital.
5. If you have any problem such as bleeding, pain, water leakage, contractions or other obstetrical condition, this is best evaluated in Labor and Delivery.

We realize that this may result in some inconvenience to our obstetrical patients; however, the security of our patients and staff is very important. Huntington is one of many hospitals that is moving to restrict access, especially during hours where visitors normally would not be expected.
